

PROLOGUE:-

Education, Progress and Prosperity of a country have close links. It is upon education that the development of a country rests. In the present times no country can think of social or economic development without any proper planning in education. It is a fact that an educationally advanced country is socially and economically advanced. This is possible only through proper planning. To enable a nation to ascend on the ladder of progress the planning in education is the primary condition.

"Institutional planning is a programme of development and improvement prepared by an educational institution on the basis of its needs and the resources available or likely to be available, with a view to improving the school programme and school practices. It is based on the principle of optimum utilization of the resources available in and around the Vidyalaya."

In this regard, Confucius, an eminent Educationist has rightly said that, "A man who does not think and plan long ahead, will find trouble right at his door." Planning is a purposeful action. It has certain objectives and ends to achieve. All the objectives are directed towards the provision of the opportunities to the Indian masses to lead a good life. There is democratic planning in India. It is centralized no doubt but its emphasis is on decentralized units at village level. The same principle is also found in the field of education.

"Institutional planning is a program of development and improvement prepared by an educational institution on the basis of its felt needs and the resources available or likely to be available, with a view to improving the school program and school practices. It is based on the principle of optimum utilization of the resources available in and around the school."

"TO REACH THE PINNACLE OF PERFECTION AN INSTITUTION NEEDS PROPER PLANNING, OPTIMUM IMPLEMENTATION, AND WHOLE HEARTED EFFORT OF ALL THE MEMBERS OF THE INSTITUTION, EFFECTIVE SUPERVISION FROM HEAD OF THE INSTITUTION AND DEDICATION FROM ONE AND ALL."

AN INTRODUCTION TO NAVODAYA VIDYALAYAS :-

The Navodaya Vidyalaya System is a unique experiment unparalleled in the annals of school education in India and elsewhere. Its significance lies in the selection of talented rural children as the target group and the attempt to provide them with quality education comparable to the best in a residential school system. Quality education would enable students from rural areas to compete with their urban counterparts on an equal footing.

The National Policy on Education-1986 envisaged setting up of residential schools, to be called Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas that would bring out the best of rural talent and following the same, Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya, Jalapur Nagin District – Kanpur Dehat was established in 1999. After 22 years of its establishment this Vidyalaya has proved its identity in providing talented and dynamic citizens to the society.

The Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti functions through an Executive Committee under the Chairmanship of Honourable Minister of EDUCATION. It is responsible for the management of all affairs including allocation of funds to the Samiti and has the authority to exercise all powers of the Samiti. The Executive Committee is assisted by two Sub-Committees, i.e. Finance Committee and Academic Advisory Committee, in its functions. The executive head of the administrative pyramid is the Commissioner who executes the policies laid down by the Samiti's Executive Committee. He/she is assisted at the Headquarter level by Joint Commissioners, Deputy Commissioners and Asstt. Commissioners. At the Regional level, he/she is assisted by the Deputy Commissioner and Asstt. Commissioners. The Samiti has established 8 Regional Offices for the administration and monitoring of Navodaya Vidyalayas under their jurisdiction. For each Vidyalaya, there is a Vidyalaya Advisory Committee and a Vidyalaya Management Committee for the general supervision of the Vidyalaya. District Magistrate of the concerned district is the Chairman of Vidyalaya Management Committee with local educationists, public representatives and officers from the District as members. The Vidyalaya Management Committee has two sub-committees i.e. Vidyalaya Purchase Advisory Sub-Committee and Vidyalaya Appointments Sub-Committee.

The aim of this Institution Plan is to lead this Institution to run smoothly and to reach the onset goal of the Vidyalaya. The basic objective of the planning remains to follow a systematic approach, a blue print for an institution to improve & develop its activities within a time frame.

Salient Features of Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya

Admission:-

- Admission to Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya is totally on the basis of merit and Admission in Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya is primarily for children from the rural areas, with provision of at least 75% seats for rural children. Seats are reserved for children from SC and ST communities in proportion to their population in the district but not less than the national average. 1/3 of the seats are filled by girl students. 3% of the seats are reserved for disabled children.
- Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas draw their students strength from talented children, selected on the basis of a merit test, called the Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya Selection Test, designed, developed and conducted initially by NCERT and now by CBSE. The test is held annually on an All India basis and at block and district levels. The test is objective, class neutral and is so designed as to ensure that rural children are not at a disadvantage while attempting it.

Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas are affiliated to CBSE and offer free education to talented children from Class-VI to XII. Entry to Navodaya Vidyalaya is made in Class-VI as well as through lateral entry in Classes- IX & XI each against vacant seat, if any. Navodaya Vidyalaya is a co-educational residential institution providing free boarding and lodging, free school uniforms, text books, stationery, and to and fro rail and bus fare to students. However, a nominal fee @ Rs. 600/- per month is charged from students of Classes- IX to XII as Vidyalaya Vikas Nidhi. The students belonging to SC/ST categories, girls and children of the families Below Poverty Line (BPL) are exempted from payment of this fee. VVN is collected @ Rs. 1500/- per student per month from the students whose parents are Govt. Employees.

Adherence to Three-Language Formula:-

The Scheme of Navodaya Vidyalayas provides for implementation of the *Three Language Formula*. The third language taught in Hindi speaking districts is the language of the linked District for migration. All Navodaya Vidyalayas follow the Three Language Formula i.e. Regional language, English and Hindi.

Promotion of National Integration:-

Navodaya Vidyalayas aim at inculcating values of National integration through migration scheme. Migration is an inter-regional exchange of students between Hindi and Non-Hindi speaking districts, which takes place for one academic year in Class-IX. Efforts are made to promote better understanding of the unity in diversity and to develop and promote understanding of the rich cultural heritage through various activities.

Facility for Students :-

Following facilities are provided to the students in JNVs at free of cost:-

- **Education:-Free Education.**
However, a nominal fee @ Rs. 600/- per month is charged from students of Classes- IX to XII as Vidyalaya Vikas Nidhi. The students belonging to SC/ST categories, girls and children of the families Below Poverty Line (BPL) are exempted from payment of this fee. VVN is collected @ Rs. 1500/- per student per month from the students whose parents are Govt. Employees.
- **Boarding facilities:- Free Accommodation.**
- **Messing facilities:-** For JNVs located at other than hard and difficult areas Rs.14283/-Per student per year
(Rs.1587/- per student per month for 9 months)
(In addition, for miscellaneous mess expenditure including fuel for cooking, cleaning/washing and wages for casual workers engaged for cooking, an additional amount of Rs. 353/- per child per month (for 9 months) is also approved.
- **Uniform :-** Rs. 3000/-per student per annum for JNVs located in extreme summer and normal winter areas like Uttar Pradesh.
- **Bedding:-**Rs 720/- per student per year.
- **Text books:-** Rs. 400/- per student per year.
- **Stationery (such as pen, pencil, eraser, scale, geometry box, note books, school bag):-** Rs. 102/- per student per month for 9 months.
- **Daily use items(Bathing soap, Washing soap, Tooth paste, Tooth brush, Shoe polish, Hair oil, Washing and ironing of cloths, Sanitary napkins for girls and other miscellaneous cleaning items) :-**
Rs. 1200/- per student for 09 Months.

Following expenditure on students are also born by NVS:-

- **Travel expenditure of students by IIIAC in train.**
- **Medical expenditure:-** Medical Expenses @ Rs. 36/- per child per month for 09 months = Rs. 324/-
- **CBSE-Fee :-** Actual.
- **School Bag for class VI, & IX students only –** Rs. 360/ Each.
- **Daily allowance to student during journey only for participating in various events/activities outside the JNV is** Rs 300/- per day
Otherwise it is Rs. 150/- per day during movement.

Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya, Jalalpur Nagin, Kanpur Dehat:-

The 18 Aug 1998 was the most auspicious day when the foundation stone of Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya, Jalalpur Nagin, District Kanpur Dehat was laid. The school campus covers around 28 acres of land with its buildings connected by steep and windy paths and offering spectacular views at every turn. These buildings include the beautiful old Quad, the modern state of art infrastructure and the newly-refurbished student hostels and staff quarters. The academic buildings including several classrooms are linked by a computer network. The widespread use of email and an internet system shrinks the distances and keeps staff, students and administration in quick and easy contact with one another. The Vidyalaya is surrounded by the grove of trees at about one kilometre from the main Kanpur Jhansi National Highway (NH-27), at Jalalpur Nagin. The school is located on the lap of exotic natural surroundings, at village Jalalpur Nagin.

Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya Kanpur Dehat is a co-educational residential institution affiliated to CBSE, offering free education to talented children from Class-VI to XII and is providing free boarding and lodging, free school uniforms, text books, stationery, and to and fro rail and bus fare to students.

Objectives of Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya, Kanpur Dehat :-

- To provide good quality modern education including a strong component of culture, inculcation of values, awareness of the environment, adventure activities and physical education to the talented children predominantly from the rural areas without regard to their family's socio-economic condition.
- To nurture and promote the talent and creativity of the students and making them more resourceful, innovative creative, competitive and adoptive.
- To promote National Integration and enrich the social content through cultural exchange with the linked JNV Mansa Panjab.
- To provide facilities, at a suitable stage, for instruction through a common medium, viz., Hindi and English.
- To follow the common core-curriculum to ensure comparability in standards and to facilitate and understand the common and composite heritage of our people.
- To serve as a focal point for improvement in quality of school education through training of teachers in live situations and sharing of experiences and facilities.
- To maintain and manage hostels for the residence of students.
- To do all such things as may be considered necessary, incidental or conducive to the attainment of all or any of the objects of the society.

Safety and Security:-

NVS has adopted "zero tolerance policy" as regards safety and security of students. Comprehensive guidelines have been issued in this regard from time to time. All Teachers and Non teaching staff have been educated about the importance of safety and security of children through various induction courses and the outcome has been found to be good.

FOURTEEN POINT PROGRAMME FOR MONITORING SAFETY AND SECURITY OF CHILDREN

1. **Daily verification of M.O.D. report by the Principal.**
2. **Monthly updating of students medical records and verification by the Principal.**
3. **Daily visit of House-Master to dormitory, interaction with children particularly migrated children, along with verification of issue of student's articles in time.**
4. **Availability of drinking water and maintenance of running water facility to toilets and bathrooms.**
5. **Nominating a suitable Counsellor for counselling of emotionally disturbed children.**
6. **Assigning Rotational responsibility to designated staff for supervision of physical hazards/danger points in and around campus and taking remedial action.**
7. **Weekly review meeting by Principal with House-Masters and House Captains.**
8. **Operational zing Vidyalaya Control Register, M&R/complaint Register and grievance box. All to be directly monitored by Principal.**
9. **Locking dormitory during day time and school building during night.**
10. **Cleaning of bushes and adequate lightening in the campus.**
11. **Regulating entry/exit at Main Gate.**
12. **Proper repairs of boundary walls.**
13. **Monthly fumigation in campus to control insects/mosquitoes etc.**
14. **Sick children to stay in MI Room under supervision of Staff Nurse and not in dormitories during day time.**

Medium of Instruction:-

The medium of instruction is mother-tongue/regional language up to Class VIII. Thereafter (i.e. Class IX onwards) the common medium (Hindi/English) is followed in the Vidyalaya.

Health Care:-

- A full time Staff Nurse is posted in this JNV to deal with emergency.
- A part – time Doctor Dr Arunendra is appointed to make visit to the Vidyalaya at regular interval at least twice a week to see the emergency or routine medical check up of the students.
- Additionally, two Counselors (Male and Female) are appointed on Contract for counseling of students (for boys and girls respectively). However only one Lady counsellor has joined so far.
- In addition to it, facility of Vehicle to respond in case of any emergency is also provided.

Protection of Children from Sexual Offences:-

Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act 2012 has been implemented in JNVs. Necessary instructions have been issued regarding prevention of Sexual Abuse of Girl Child. A School Complaint Committee (S.C.C.) has been set up in the Vidyalaya to serve as complaints and redresses body. This Committee shall be chaired by the Principal/Vice- Principal of the school, and shall consist of five other members, i.e. one male teacher, one female teacher, one female student, one male student and one non-teaching staff member and will work under the Cluster Complaint Committee (C.C.C.), with the Assistant Commissioner in-charge of the Cluster as its Coordinator. In addition, each of these Committees shall have a female officer as a member.

Before starting teaching in class, a few minutes will be given to enquire about the assignment done by students as given on the last day. The teacher will check these assignments once in a week & will submit its report along with Notebooks once in a month in prescribed Performa to the Principal/Senior Most Teacher.

Teachers will check the home work of students strictly as per guidelines issued by CBSE and will evaluate the assigned task properly and thoroughly. The members of Examination committee constituted at Vidyalaya level will ensure that the student's performances at all the fields are evaluated properly and regularly. Signature with date must be put on the evaluation sheet. The evaluated answer-sheets would be shown to students and, if demanded, to the parents also. The same would be kept as record with the Examination-In-Charge as evidence for verification by the CBSE.

6. Internal Examination:-

7. JNVST Registration:-

The target is to enhance JNVST registration by 15 % by involving Parents, Students, Staff, Alumni, Social Workers, District Education Department, and District Administration. Lateral Entry admission in Class IX & XI will be done as per the guidelines of NVS. Separate Campaign will be organized at different Blocks to educate rural people about the system of Navodaya so as to enhance the opportunity for the students of the rural background to register for the JNVST. District Magistrate and Chairman of the Vidyalaya Management Committee will be requested to issue DO letter to all Blocks for ensuring enhancement of registration and extending the Scheme of Navodaya to maximum students.

8. Migration Scheme:-

One of the important features of the JNV scheme is an exchange programme wherein students visit JNVs in different linguistic regions to promote understanding of the diversity and plurality of India's culture and its people. The aim of the exchange program is focused on National Integration. According to

the scheme, selected 30% of 9th class students are exchanged between JNVs of non-Hindi speaking region and Hindi speaking region, for one year and students of two collaborated Navodayas are taught languages of their associated state as third language for four years, from class 6th-9th. Navodaya gives life time experiences to their students.

JNV Kanpur Dehat has been allotted Panjabi as third language and JNV Mansa has been linked with this Vidyalaya to strengthen migration and National Integrations. Efforts are made to promote better Understanding of the unity in diversity and cultural heritage through various activities.

9. Science Exhibition/NCSC:-

The exhibits for Cluster/Regional level Science/Social Science/Maths /SUPW exhibition and the Projects of National Level Children Science Congress will be prepared as per the guidelines of NVS RO Lucknow. 23. VACATION SCHEDULE:

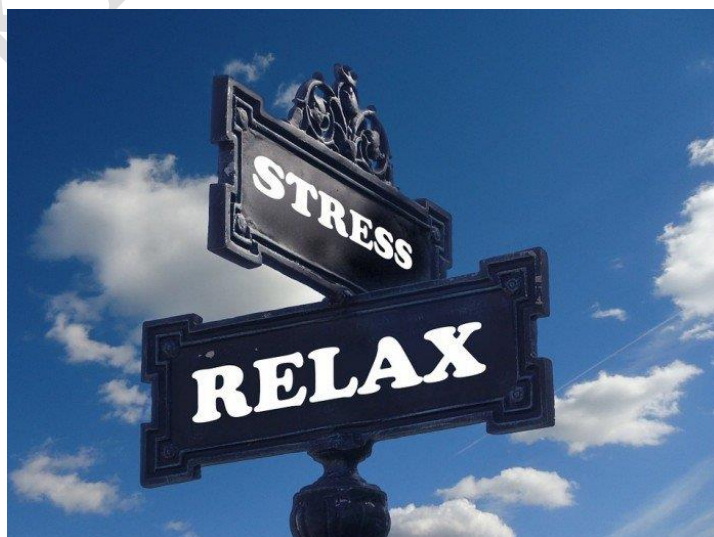
In compliance to NVS Vacation Schedule, the Vidyalaya will observe the following Vacation Schedule:

ADMINISTRATION

23. Safety & Security of the Students:

Safety & Security of the students holds the Top priority and will be ensured as per the guidelines on Safety & Security issued vide NVS letter No F.No.2/41/2001-NVS(SA) dated 13th Aug. 2001 and various guidelines issued on the subject from time to time. A copy of the same has been provided to each staff members for its strict compliance. A separate committee headed by Sh DN Tiwari PGT Economics has also been constituted for the implementation of said guidelines. The review of safety & security will be done on monthly basis and report will be submitted to R.O. regularly.

All initiatives are taken for ensuring safety at each step in the Vidyalaya as well as in Hostels. Serviceability of all electric points, toilets, bathrooms and availability of drinking waters etc. are ensured with daily reports of MOD.

24. House System:

Students are divided into four houses named as Aravali, Neegiri, Shivalik and Udaigiri, They are named after Mountain Ranges in India. The hostels are divided into two sections, one for senior students (IX,X,XI, XII Standard) and other for junior students (VI,VII,VIII Standard) and is same for both girls and boys.

The proper residential culture will be developed among students in the Vidyalaya and the students will be trained to work effectively and they do themselves every work. All effort will be made to develop a cohesive environment by strengthening the House system. All house activities will be organized strictly as per NVS letter no. F.25-5/99-NVS (Acad.) dated 29th March 2000 as well as in accordance with the Perspective Academic Planning 2021-22. A copy of the same has been provided to each staff member for its compliance. The house system will be developed in such a way that the student will feel it as a home away from home. Monthly House meeting is planned on last Saturday of every month and has been circulated in Annual Calendar.

There are four senior as well as four junior Houses i.e. total 8 Houses for Boys and four Houses for Girls.

Competitions for sports activities will be held separately for Seniors and Juniors Boys and Girls respectively. CCA competitions too will be conducted for Seniors and Juniors separately.

25. School Discipline:

All efforts will be made to develop a disciplined culture among students. House Masters / House Mistress / Subject Teachers will keep close watch on each and every activity of the students. If at any juncture it is found that the student is going out of track immediate necessary steps will be taken with proper counseling at various levels. The role of Parent Teacher's Council will be activated in this regard. A committee consisting of following members has been constituted to take up the cases of indiscipline and suggest disciplinary actions against the student if needed.

- (b) All House Masters/Mistress+ PETs
- (c) Parent Representative

26. Upkeep of JNV Campus:

A plan of action for the purpose has been prepared and duties & responsibilities are being entrusted with all the members of the staff by allotting the specific area. A campaign will be launched to plant at least 200 trees in first phase to develop house wise garden/kitchen garden.

27. Mess System:

The Vice Principal/Senior Most Teacher has been given the responsibility to run the Vidyalaya Mess through Mess committee constituted as per the guidelines issued by NVS letter F.25-5/99-NVS (Acad.) dated 26th Feb. 2001. A copy of the same has been provided to all staff members for compliance. To ensure the maintenance and proper cleanliness in the Mess, regular (monthly) meeting will be held as per above cited letter and suggestions as proposed by the students will be considered as per the feasibility. The Mess committee will decide menu duly approved during Monthly Mess meeting.

28. Daily Use Items:

A Calendar has been designed for distribution of Daily Use Items as per the guidelines of NVS keeping the Budget in mind and to ensure transparency. Store Keeper has been directed to ensure the distribution of items as per the Calendar.

Copy of the same is enclosed.

29. Staff welfare:- The best possible working condition will be provided for staffs per resources available in the Vidyalaya so that they are able to contribute willingly in all activities entrusted to them. Efforts are made to organize special get together at least twice in the session in which spouses & children of staff will participate. A committee of teachers will plan how the teacher can be provided better facilities so as to have addition of feather in the development of the Vidyalaya.
